Chapter Championship

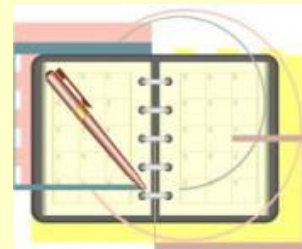
