ACTIVATE - Encourage and reward volunteer service and provide opportunities to develop leadership skills.

To bring you new, innovative and high quality activities, we want to increase participation of members in our volunteer corps as well as retain those volunteers through the use of incentives and recognition programs.

For those of you that are new to the chapter or seasoned members that may have forgotten when these were published in the past, we do offer the following incentives for volunteers that help out with our chapter activities:

Monthly Volunteer Recognition: We have monthly drawings for anyone that volunteered in the month (these will be publicized in our eblasts so you can see who won and what they did!)

League Captain Recognition: Captains attend a League Captain's Dinner for training and sharing of ideas. They also receive one session of league free for their efforts coordinating their league site and disseminating information for the Board to the members about upcoming activities.
